Dear Parents:

As the 2017-2018 school year ends, we are looking forward to the 2018-2019 school year. We have been thrilled with the success of the Youth Zone program at Tony Aguirre. We are going to expand our program to multiple sites for 2018-2019, which will give families the opportunity to structure their child's out of school experience to fit their interests and strengths.

We will be adding TWO additional sites to our after school program. Each site will have their own focus for out of school programming so that families can choose which type of programming their students are involved in.
